

# 2023-2024 Respiratory Disease

## Influenza

#### Week 12 (ending March 23)

- Seasonal influenza activity remains elevated nationally but is decreasing.
- 10.5% positivity
- Most frequent virus: A(H1N1)pdm09, A(H3N2), B viruses
- Outpatient Respiratory Illness: 3.1%

#### Preliminary In-Season Estimates

• Illnesses: 31-58 M

Medical Visits: 14-27 M

Hospitalizations: 350,000-720,000

• Deaths: 22,000-63,000

### Delaware ILI Activity Level: Minimal

• Hospitalizations, YTD: 72

• Deaths, YTD: 6

Percentage Vaccinated: 32.1%
