Measles 2025

Nationwide (4/18/25)

- 10 Confirmed Outbreaks (3+ related cases)
- 94% of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 800 Confirmed Cases, 25 Jurisdictions
 - Alaska, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Geogia, Hawai'i, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Washington

- Age Ranges
 - 0-4: 249 (31%)
 - 5-19: 304 (38%)
 - 20+: 231 (29%)
 - Unknown: 16 (2%)
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 96%
 - One MMR dose: 1%
 - Two MMR doses: 2%
- Hospitalizations: 85 (11%)
- Deaths: 3

Texas (4/18/25)

- 597 cases, 62 hospitalizations
- 2 deaths (unvaccinated school-aged children)
- 25 counties affected (Gaines Co: 371, 62.1% of cases)

- Vaccation Status:
 - Unknown/Unvaccinated: 575
 - Vaccinated with at least one dose: 10
