MMWR Weekly (No 16)

- The association of reported experiences of racial and ethnic discrimination in health care with COVID-19 vaccination status and intent
- Use of COVIDTests.gov at-home test kits among adults in a national household probability sample

Food & Drug Administration (Announcements)

- Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna COVID-19 bivalent mRNA vaccine EUAs ammended to simplify the vaccination schedule - the current bivalent strains are now authorized to be used for all doses administered to individuals aged 6 months and older.
- Monovalent Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines are no longer authorized for use in the United States.

2022-2023 Flu Season

Week 15 (week ending April 15)

- Clinical Lab positivity: 1%
- Public Health Lab: Most frequently reported viruses: A(H1N1) and B
- Outpatient respiratory illness: 2.0%
