




2021-2022 Flu Season

Week 12 (March 20-26, 2022)

United States

Influenza activity is still highest in the central and south-central regions of the country but appears to be declining slightly in these regions. Influenza activity is increasing in the northeast and northwest regions.



Delaware (Widespread)

There have been 1,033 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.

Preliminary Burden Estimates (October 1, 2021 – March 26, 2022)

• Flu illnesses: 3.5 million – 5.8 million

Flu medical visits: 1.6 million – 2.7 million
Flu hospitalizations: 34,000 – 69,000

• Flu deaths: 2,000 – 5,800
