# Eliminating Hepatitis B from Day One: The Power of Hepatitis B Birth Dose Vaccination

April 7-8, 2025

Hepatitis B vaccination at birth is critical to protecting all babies from hepatitis B and liver disease. This early administration is crucial as newborns exposed to the hepatitis B virus (HBV) are at a high risk of developing chronic hepatitis B, which can lead to serious liver diseases in adulthood. This **two-part webinar** from the Coalition for Global Hepatitis Elimination will highlight how state and city immunization programs and local clinicians work with families to ensure timely hepatitis B birth dose vaccination of all newborns in the United States.

# Respiratory Virus Activity Levels

(CDC.gov, updated April 4, 2025)

- The amount of acute respiratory illness causing people to seek healthcare remains at a low level
- ED visits
  - Diagnosed influenza: low
  - RSV: low
  - COVID-19: low
- Test positivity
  - Influenza: 9.7%
  - RSV: 4.1%
  - COVID-19: 3.7%
- Wastewater
  - Influenza A: low
  - RSV: very low
  - COVID-19: low
- Predictions: COVID ED visits will decline from a low to a very low level; influenza ED vistis will remain at a low level

# Measles 2025

### Nationwide (4/4/25)

- 6 Confirmed Outbreaks (3+ related cases)
- 93% of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 607 Confirmed Cases, 22 Jurisdictions
  - Alaska, California, Colorado, Florida, Geogia, Kansas, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Washington
- Age Ranges
  - 0-4: 196 (32%)
  - 5-19: 240 (40%)
  - 20+: 159 (26%)
- Vaccination Status
  - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 97%
  - One MMR dose: 1%
  - Two MMR doses: 2%
- Hospitalizations: 74 (12%)
- Deaths: 3

#### <u>Texas</u> (4/4/25)

- 481 cases, 56 hospitalizations
- 2 deaths (unvaccinated school-aged children)

- 19 counties affected (Gaines Co: 315, 65.5% of cases)
- Age Ranges:
  - 0-4: 157
  - 5-17: 180
  - 18+: 119
  - Pending: 25
- Vaccation Status:Unknown/Unvaccinated: 471
  - Vaccinated with at least one dose: 3
  - Vaccinated with 2+ doses: 7

## New Mexico (4/4/25)

- 1 death (unvaccinated adult)
- 2 counties affected

  - 5-17: 15

  - Pending: 0
- Vaccination Status:
  - Not vaccinated: 36
  - Unknown: 12
  - Vaccinated with at least one dose: 6

### Kansas (4/2/25)


