# 2023-2024 Respiratory Disease

### Influenza

Week 13 (ending March 30)

- Seasonal influenza activity remains elevated nationally but is decreasing.
- 9.1% positivity
- Most frequent virus: A(H1N1)pdm09, A(H3N2), B viruses
- Outpatient Respiratory Illness: 3.0%

### Preliminary In-Season Estimates

Illnesses: 32-59 MMedical Visits: 15-27 M

Hospitalizations: 360,000-730,000

• Deaths: 22,000-65,000

Delaware ILI Activity Level: MinimalHospitalizations, YTD: 72
