Avian-Bovine-Human Flu Transmission

Updated: 8/13/24.

Human cases: 13 (current outbreak)

- 4 following exposure to dairy cows ([report](#)) (TX-1, MI-2, CO-1)
- 9 following exposure to poultry ([report](#)) (CO)
- Current public health risk: LOW
- CDC flu surveillance systems show no indicators of unusual influenza activity in people, including avian influenza A(H5N1).
- 9 of the 14 H5 human cases have been confirmed as H5N1

Birds

- Wild birds: 9,725
- Poultry: 100,712,371
- Jurisdictions with Bird Flu in Wild Birds: 51
- States with Poultry Outbreaks: 48 (Includes DE in New Castle and Kent)

Cattle

- States with Cattle Outbreaks: 13 (CO, IA, ID, KS, MI, MN, NC, NM, OH, OK, SD, TX, WY)
- Dairy Herds Affected: 191
