Avian-Bovine-Human Flu Transmission

Updated: 8/02/24.

Human cases: 13 (current outbreak)

- 4 following exposure to dairy cows (<u>report</u>) (TX-1, MI-2, CO-1)
- 9 following exposure to poultry (report) (CO)
- Current public health risk: LOW
- CDC flu surveillance systems show no indicators of unusual influenza activity in people, including avian influenza A(H5N1).
- 9 of the 14 H5 human cases have been confirmed as H5N1

Birds

- Wild birds: 9,674
- Poultry: 100,707,371
- Jurisdictions with Bird Flu in Wild Birds: 50
- States with Poultry Outbreaks: 48 (Includes DE in New Castle and Kent)

Cattle

- States with Cattle Outbreaks: 13 (CO, IA, ID, KS, MI, MN, NC, NM, OH, OK, SD, TX, WY)

Measles Outbreak 2024

As of August 1, 2024, a total of 203 measles cases were reported by 27 jurisdictions: Arizona, California, District of Colombia, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.

There have been 13 outbreaks (defined as 3 or more related cases) reported in 2024, and 63% of cases (127 of 203) are outbreak-associated.

Total Cases: 203 Total Hospitalizations: 46% (94 of 203)

Vaccination Status

- Unvaccinated/Unknown: 86%
- One MMR Dose: 9%
- Two MMR Doses: 5%

Hospitalizations: 46%

- Under 5 years: 49 of 82 (60%)
- 5-19 years: 17 of 56 (30%)
- 20+ years: 28 out of 65 (43%)


