

2024-2025 Respiratory Disease

Respiratory Virus Activity Levels

(CDC.gov, updated January 31, 2025)

- The amount of acute respiratory illness causing people to seek healthcare remains high
- ED visits
 - Diagnosed influenza: very high
 - RSV: moderate
 - COVID-19: low
- Test positivity
 - Influenza: 29.4%
 - RSV: 7.6%
 - COVID-19: 5.4%
 - Wastewater
 - Influenza A: very high
 - RSV: moderate
 - COVID-19: high
- Predictions: COVID ED visits will remain at a lower level compared to previous winters; influenza ED vistis will remain high and will increase in most states
