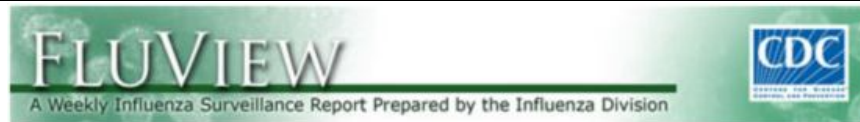

- Three human rabies deaths attributed to bat exposures

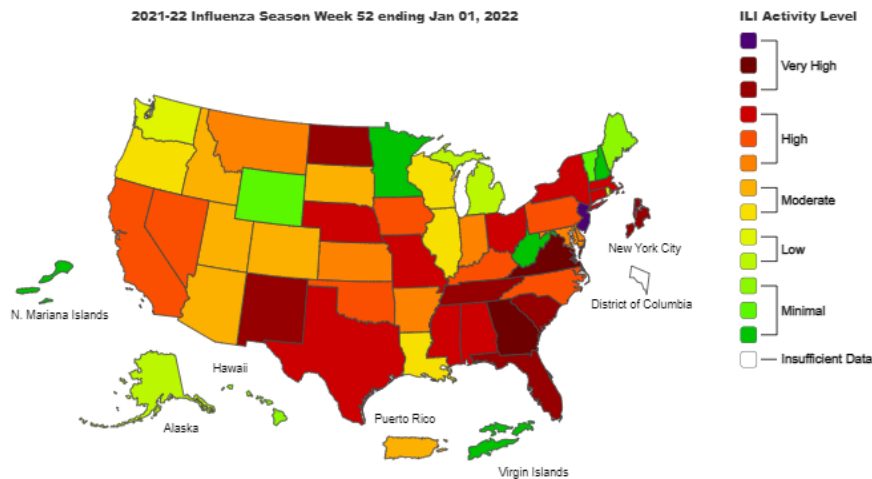


2021-2022 Flu Season

Week 52 (December 26, 2021 – January 1, 2022)

United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States is increasing, including indicators that track hospitalizations. The amount of activity varies by region.



Delaware (Widespread)

There have been 550 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.

Preliminary Burden Estimates

- Flu illnesses: 1.2 Million – 2.1 Million
- Flu medical visits: 540,000 – 910,000
- Flu hospitalizations: 12,000 – 25,000
- Flu deaths: 730 – 2,200
