


2021-2022 Flu Season

Week 1 (January 2-8, 2022)

United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States declined slightly this week but remains elevated and is expected to continue for several weeks. The amount of activity varies by region.



Delaware (Widespread)

There have been 550 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.

Preliminary Burden Estimates (October 1, 2021 – January 8, 2022)

Flu illnesses: 1.6 million – 2.7 million
Flu medical visits: 730,000 – 1.2 million
Flu hospitalizations: 16,000 – 33,000

• Flu deaths: 970 – 2,900
