On Tuesday, January 21, President Trump directed federal health agencies, including the CDC, FDA, and NIH, to <u>pause external communications</u>, including regular scientific reports, and updates to websites and health advisories. In a follow up memo, Acting Health Secretary Dr. Dorothy Fink indicated the directive would be in effect through February 1.

"As the new Administration considers its plan for managing the federal policy and public communications processes, it is important that the President's appointees and designees have the opportunity to review and approve any regulations, guidance documents, and other public documents and communications (including social media)."


Respiratory Virus Activity Levels
