Human cases: 5

- 4 following exposure to dairy cows (<u>report</u>) (TX-1, MI-2, CO-1)
- 1 following exposure to poultry (2022)
- Current public health risk: LOW
- Using flu surveillance systems to monitor for H5N1 activity in humans

Measles Outbreak 2024

As of June 27, 2024, a total of 159 measles cases were reported by 23 jurisdictions: Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.

There have been 12 outbreaks (defined as 3 or more related cases) reported in 2024, and 66% of cases (105 of 159) are outbreak-associated.

Total Cases: 159

Total Hospitalizations: 53% (85 of 159)

Vaccination Status

• Unvaccinated/Unknown: 84%

One MMR Dose: 11%Two MMR Doses: 5%

Hospitalizations: 53%

Under 5 years: 45 of 73 (62%)
5-19 years: 15 of 36 (42%)
20+ years: 25 out of 50 (50%)
