Avian-Bovine-Human Flu Transmission

Updated: 7/12/24.

Human cases: 5

- 4 following exposure to dairy cows (<u>report</u>) (TX-1, MI-2, CO-1)
- 1 following exposure to poultry (2022)
- Current public health risk: LOW
- CDC flu surveillance systems show no indicators of unusual influenza activity in people, including avian influenza A(H5N1).

Birds

- Wild birds: 9,528
- Poultry: 99,095,946
- Jurisdictions with Bird Flu in Wild Birds: 50
- States with Poultry Outbreaks: 48 (Includes DE in New Castle and Kent)

Cattle

- States with Cattle Outbreaks: 12 (CO, IA, ID, KS, MI, MN, NC, NM, OH, SD, TX, WY)
- Dairy Herds Affected: 151

Measles Outbreak 2024

As of July 11, 2024, a total of 167 measles cases were reported by 24 jurisdictions: Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.

There have been 13 outbreaks (defined as 3 or more related cases) reported in 2024, and 66% of cases (110 of 167) are outbreak-associated.

Total Cases: 167 Total Hospitalizations: 53% (88 of 167)

Vaccination Status

- Unvaccinated/Unknown: 84%
- One MMR Dose: 11%
- Two MMR Doses: 5%

Hospitalizations: 53%

- Under 5 years: 47 of 77 (61%)
- 5-19 years: 15 of 37 (41%)
- 20+ years: 26 out of 53 (49%)


