Measles 2025

[Nationwide](#) (CDC, 7/17/26)

In 2026:

2,260 Confirmed Cases, 44 Jurisdictions (including District of Colombia (1), Maryland (9), New Jersey (1), Pennsylvania (110), and Virginia (176))

- 34 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 2,108 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 15 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 93%
 - One MMR Dose: 3%
 - Two MMR Doses: 4%

Under 5	451 (20%)	45 (10%)
5-19 years	1,130 (50%)	37 (3%)
20+ years	672 (30%)	64 (10%)
Unknown	7 (<1%)	0

July 17: Ebola Disease (Bundibugyo Virus) - DRC & Uganda

- DRC: 2,124 cases, 828 deaths
- Uganda: 20 cases, 2 deaths (+1 probable case & death). No new Ugandan cases since 6/21/26; in 42 day enhanced surveillance phase
