Measles 2025

In 2026:

2,318 Confirmed Cases, 45 Jurisdictions (including **Delaware (4)**, District of Colombia (1), Maryland (11), New Jersey (1), Pennsylvania (134), and Virginia (176))

- 35 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 2,153 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 16 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 93%
 - One MMR Dose: 3%
 - Two MMR Doses: 4%

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Delaware Declares Measles Outbreak

The Division of Public Health is now reporting **four positive measles cases** in the state. The CDC defines an outbreak as three or more cases connected by time and location.

The cases identified to date are unvaccinated males in Kent County. Extensive contact tracing is ongoing to identify anyone exposed to the individuals who tested positive.
