Measles 2025

[Nationwide](#) (CDC, 7/02/26)

In 2026:

2,170 Confirmed Cases, 41 Jurisdictions (including District of Colombia (1), Maryland (4), New Jersey (1), Pennsylvania (90), and Virginia (144))

- 31 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 2,019 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 12 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 93%
 - One MMR Dose: 4%
 - Two MMR Doses: 4%

Under 5	442 (20%)	43 (10%)
5-19 years	1,097 (51%)	35 (3%)
20+ years	625 (29%)	60 (9%)
Unknown	6 (<1%)	0

June 24: Yellow Fever - Global

June 25: Nipah Virus Disease - India

July 2: Hantavirus Outbreak - Cruise Ship

- No longer poses a public health risk
- 13 cases, 3 deaths (CFR 23%)

July 3: Ebola Disease (Bundibugyo Virus) - DRC & Uganda

- DRC: 1,460 cases, 452 deaths
- Uganda: 20 cases, 2 deaths (+1 probable case & death). No new Ugandan cases since 6/21/26
