In 2026:

1,983 Confirmed Cases, 40 Jurisdictions (Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming)

- 30 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 1,847 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 9 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 92%
 - One MMR Dose: 4%
 - Two MMR Doses: 4%

May 29: Ebola Disease caused by Bundibugyo virus - DRC & Uganda

- [Bundibugyo virus disease](#) outbreak in DRC and Uganda continues to evolve; case numbers at 906 suspected and 223 deaths (DRC), 134 confirmed cases and 18 deaths (9 cases in Uganda). One case in the USA of an individual who had treated patients in DRC and is now receiving in care in Germany.
