
## 2021-2022 Flu Season

Week 22 (May 29-June 4)

#### **United States**

Seasonal influenza viruses continue to circulate and activity is increasing in parts of the country.

- National respiratory specimens testing positive: 5.9%
- Influenza-associated pediatric deaths: 28



#### Preliminary Burden Estimates (October 1, 2021 – May 14, 2022)

• Flu illnesses: 7.8 million – 13 million

• Flu medical visits: 3.6 million – 5.9 million

• Flu hospitalizations: 80,000 – 160,000

• Flu deaths: 4,900 – 13,000

#### **Delaware (Widespread)**

There have been **2,656 laboratory confirmed cases** of influenza in Delaware so far this season (New Castle County: 1,259; Kent County: 585; Sussex County: 812). There have been **148 hospitalizations** and **three deaths**.
