Measles 2025

[Nationwide](#) (CDC, 6/5/26)

In 2026:

2,030 Confirmed Cases, 40 Jurisdictions (including District of Colombia (1), Maryland (3), New Jersey (1), Pennsylvania (65), and Virginia (110))

- 30 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 1,929 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 10 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 93%
 - One MMR Dose: 4%

- Two MMR Doses: 4%

Under 5	428 (21%)	42 (10%)
5-19 years	1,050 (51%)	34 (3%)
20+ years	589 (28%)	52 (9%)
Unknown	6 (0%)	0
