Although the flu season is "over," the flu is **WIDESPREAD** in Delaware.

This week, there were 43 confirmed flu cases statewide (New Castle - 23, Kent - 8, Sussex - 9). This brings the seasonal total to 2,748. There have been 152 hospitalizations and 3 deaths.
