Measles 2025

[Nationwide](#) (CDC, 6/26/26)

In 2026:

2,134 Confirmed Cases, 41 Jurisdictions (including District of Colombia (1), Maryland (4), New Jersey (1), Pennsylvania (83), and Virginia (128))

- 30 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 1,982 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 12 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 93%
 - One MMR Dose: 4%
 - Two MMR Doses: 4%

Under 5	438 (21%)	43 (10%)
5-19 years	1,083 (51%)	35 (3%)
20+ years	607 (28%)	58 (9%)

- Uganda: 19 confirmed cases, 2 deaths; 1 probable case, 1 death. No new cases since 6/5/26
