- Bivalent mRNA vaccine standing orders added to "Checklist of Current Versions of US COVID-19 Vaccination Guidance and Clinic Support Tools"
- Potential for recurrent Mpox outbreaks in gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men
- Urban and rural Mpox incidence among persons aged 15-64 years
