Measles 2025

In 2026:

2,030 Confirmed Cases, 40 Jurisdictions (Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, District of Colombia, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming)

- 30 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 1,890 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 10 cases reported among international visitors
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 92%
 - One MMR Dose: 4%
 - Two MMR Doses: 4%

Vaccines In The News

- Ebola has reached [Mambasa](#), a part of the country run by Islamic State militants. Health workers do not travel to that area.
- Five of the 18 US cruise ship passengers who have been staying at a national quarantine facility in Nebraska after being exposed to [hantavirus](#) are going home.
- President [Trump](#) signs EO directing federal agencies to review the US childhood vaccination schedule
- [Rotavirus](#) cases are rising.
- Sec. of State Rubio told US lawmakers that the State Department will "re-engage" with [Gavi](#), the Vaccine Alliance, to resolve a funding dispute.
- WHO downsizes official case count of the [Ebola](#) outbreak in the DRC and Uganda to 321 confirmed cases, including 48 deaths, with 116 cases suspected. In Uganda, the new case count is 11 confirmed cases, 1 confirmed death, 1 probable case, and 1 probable death.
