Respiratory Virus Activity Levels

(CDC.gov, updated March 14, 2025)

- The amount of acute respiratory illness causing people to seek healthcare is moderate
- ED visits
 - Diagnosed influenza: moderate
 - RSV: lowCOVID-19: low
- Test positivity
 - Influenza: 16.1%
 - RSV: 5.8%
 - COVID-19: 3.8%
- Wastewater
 - Influenza A: moderate
 - RSV: low
 - COVID-19: low
- Predictions: COVID ED visits will remain at a low to very low level; influenza ED vistis will remain moderate but are expected to decline


