Respiratory Virus Season, 2025-2026

Centers for Disease Control & Prevention

Last update: March 27 (<https://cdc.gov>)

- Acute respiratory illnesses causing people to seek healthcare is low;
- Seasonal influenza activity: continues to decrease in most areas of the country; influenza A activity continues to decrease across all regions while influenza B activity varies by region.
- RSV activity: elevated, has peaked in many regions of the country
- COVID-19 activity: low in most areas of the country
- Delaware level of respiratory illness activity: low

In-Season Disease Burden Estimates Influenza:

Since October 1, 2025:

- Flu Illnesses: 29 - 52 Million

- Flu Medical Visits: 14 - 23 Million
- Flu Hospitalizations: 360,000 - 770,000
- Flu Deaths: 23,000 - 76,000
- Pediatric Deaths: 123

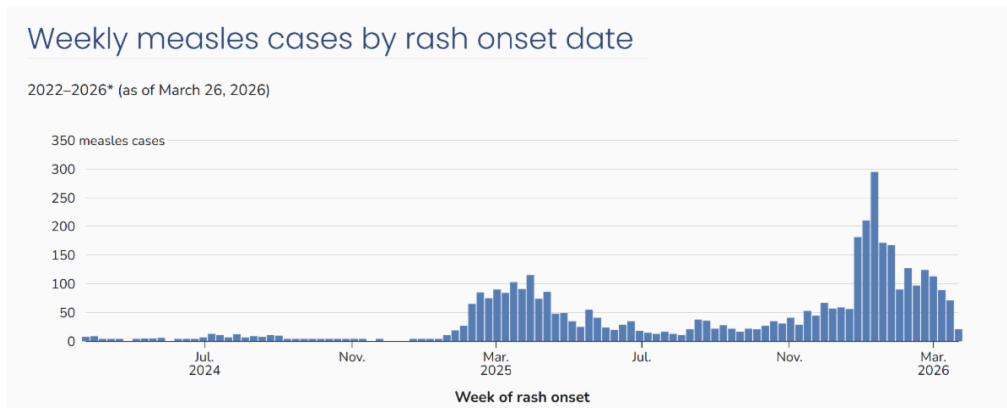
Measles 2025

In 2026:

1,575 Confirmed Cases, 32 Jurisdictions (Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Kentucky, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin)

- 16 new outbreaks reported in 2026
- 1,483 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 9 cases reported among international visitors
