




# 2021-2022 Flu Season

There have been 687 laboratory confirmed cases of influenza in Delaware so far this season.

# Preliminary Burden Estimates (October 1, 2021 – February 26, 2022)

• Flu illnesses: 2.5 million – 4.2 million

Flu medical visits: 1.2 million – 1.9 million

• Flu hospitalizations: 24,000 – 49,000

• Flu deaths: 1,400 – 4,200
