MMWR Weekly (No 17)

- Unprecedented outbreak of West Nile Virus Arizona
- Effectiveness of monovalent mRNA COVID-19 vaccination in preventing COVID-19 associated invasive mechanical ventilation and death among immunocompetent adults during omicron variant period
- Posttreatment lesions after tecovirimat treatment for Mpox

Food & Drug Administration (Announcements)

- Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, bivalent, was authorized for some immunocompromised individuals ages 6mo 4 years
- Prevnar 20 was approved for prevention of invasive disease caused by the 20 different serotypes of Streptococcus pneumonia contained in the vaccine for individuals 6 weeks through 17 years of age, and for the prevention of otitis media caused by 7 of the serotypes for children aged 6 weeks through 5 years

- Clinical Lab positivity: 0.8%
- Public Health Lab: Most frequently reported viruses: A(H1N1) and B
- Outpatient respiratory illness: 1.9%
