1,001 Confirmed Cases, 31 Jurisdictions

14 Confirmed Outbreaks (3+ related cases)

- 928 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- Age Ranges
 - 0-4: 299 (30%)
 - 5-19: 376 (38%)
 - 20+: 311 (30%)
 - Unknown: 15 (1%)
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 96%
 - One MMR dose: 2%
 - Two MMR doses: 2%
- Hospitalizations: 126 (13%)
- Deaths: 3

Texas (5/9/25)

- 709 cases, 92 hospitalizations
- 2 deaths (unvaccinated school-aged children)
- 29 counties (Gaines Co: 403, 56.8% of cases)

New Mexico (5/9/25)

- 71 cases, 7 hospitalizations
- 1 death (unvaccinated adult)
- 5 counties

Kansas (5/9/25)

- 46 cases, 1 hospitalization
- 8 counties

Ohio (5/9/25)

- 41 cases
- 10 counties

• 17 cases

- CDC reports the 2024-2025 <u>flu</u> season was the deadliest for children since the 2009-2010 H1N1 global flu pandemic
- HHS <u>announces</u> it will require all new vaccines to undergo placebocontrolled trials

- US infant mortality dropped in 2024; experts partially credit RSV shots


