14 Confirmed Outbreaks (3+ related cases)

- 961 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- Age Ranges
 - 0-4: 311 (30%)
 - 5-19: 389 (38%)
 - 20+: 336 (32%)
 - Unknown: 10 (1%)
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 96%
 - One MMR dose: 1%
 - Two MMR doses: 2%
- Hospitalizations: 127 (13%)
- Deaths: 3
