- 12 Confirmed Outbreaks (3+ related cases)
- 869 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 935 Confirmed Cases, 30 Jurisdictions
 - Alaska, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Hawai'i, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Virginia, Washington

- Age Ranges
 - 0-4: 285 (30%)
 - 5-19: 353 (38%)
 - 20+: 284 (30%)
 - Unknown: 13 (1%)
- Vaccination Status
 - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 96%
 - One MMR dose: 2%
 - Two MMR doses: 2%
- Hospitalizations: 121 (13%)
- Deaths: 3
