# Measles 2025

#### Nationwide (5/2/25)

- 12 Confirmed Outbreaks (3+ related cases)
- 869 of confirmed cases are outbreak-associated
- 935 Confirmed Cases, 30 Jurisdictions
  - Alaska, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Geogia, Hawai'i, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Virginia, Washington

- Age Ranges
  - 0-4: 285 (30%)
  - 5-19: 353 (38%)
  - 20+: 284 (30%)
  - Unknown: 13 (1%)
- Vaccination Status
  - Unvaccinated/Unknown: 96%
  - One MMR dose: 2%
- Two MMR doses: 2%Hospitalizations: 121 (13%)
- Deaths: 3

#### Texas (5/2/25)

- 683 cases, 89 hospitalizations
- 2 deaths (unvaccinated school-aged children)
- 29 counties (Gaines Co: 396, 58% of cases)

#### New Mexico (5/2/25)

- 67 cases, 7 hospitalizations
- 1 death (unvaccinated adult)
- 4 counties

#### Kansas (4/30/25)

- 46 cases, 1 hospitalization
- 8 counties

## Ohio (4/30/25)

- 33 cases
- 5 counties

#### Oklahoma (5/2/25)

• 16 cases

#### Indiana (5/2/2025)

- 8 cases
- 1 county

#### Michigan (4/24/2025)

- 9 cases
- 6 counties

#### Montana (4/29/2025)

- 7 cases
- 1 county


