### Week 17 (ending April 27)

 Seasonal influenza activity continues to decline in most areas of the country.

• 3.9% positivity

• Co-Circulating: A(H1N1)pdm09, A(H3N2), B viruses

• Outpatient Respiratory Illness: 2.2%

Hospitalizations: 380,000-790,000

# Avian-Bovine-Human Flu Transmission

Updated: 5/2/24. A farm worker on a commercial dairy farm in Texas developed conjunctivitis on approximately March 27, 2024, and subsequently tested positive for HPAI A(H5N1) virus infection. HPAI A(H5N1) viruses have been reported in the area's dairy cattle and wild birds. There have been no previous reports of the spread of HPAI viruses from cows to humans.

### CDC has collected samples and posted <u>results</u>:

Human cases: 2 (one in 2024, eposure: cows; 1 in 2022, exposure: poultry)

Wild birds: 9,296Poultry: 90,882,636

• States with Cattle Outbreaks: 9 (CO, ID, NM, TX, KS, SD, MI, OH, NC)

- Jurisdictions with Bird Flu in Wild Birds: 50
- States with Poultry Outbreaks: 48 (Includes DE in New Castle and Kent)

• Dairy Herds Affected: 36

As of May 3, 2024, a total of 131 measles cases were reported by 21 jurisdictions: Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Jersey, New York City, New York State, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.

There have been 8 outbreaks (defined as 3 or more related cases) reported in 2024, and 69% of cases (90 of 131) are outbreak-associated.

Total Cases: 131

Total Hospitalizations: 53% (70 of 131)
