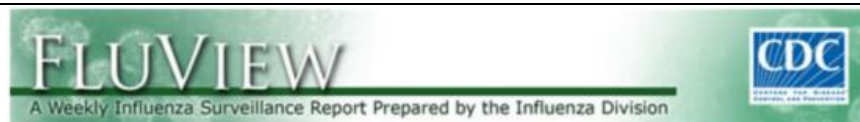

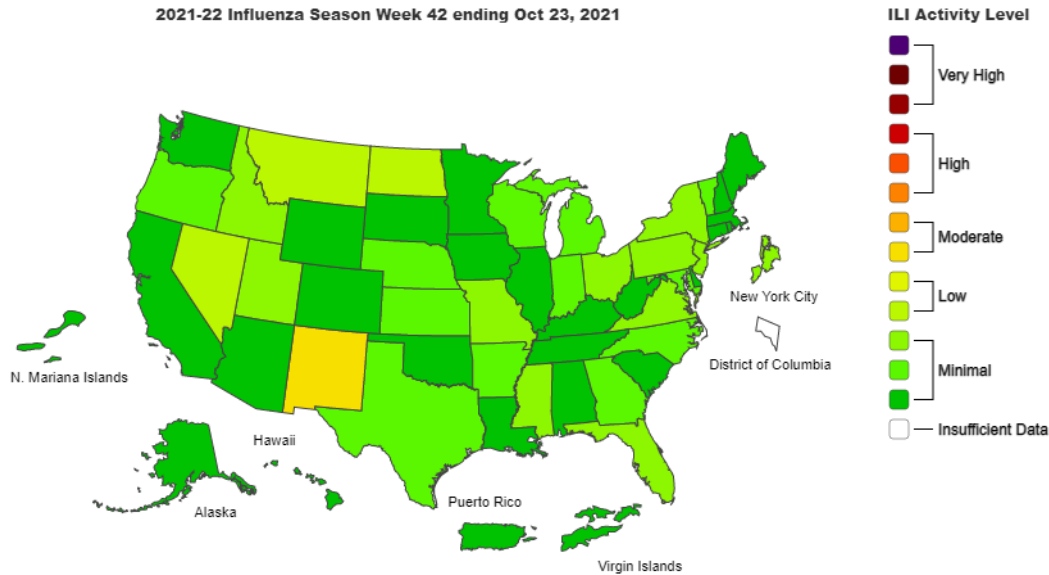


2021-2022 Flu Season
