


2021-2022 Flu Season

United States

Seasonal influenza activity in the United States remains low, but the number of influenza virus detections reported by public health laboratories has increased in recent weeks.

- Percentage of tests positive: 7.4%

- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (MyHealthyCommunity)
 - As of November 21, Delaware has administered 1,375,443 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine
 - Fully Vaccinated: 543,607 (56.8%)
 - One Dose: 620,846 (64.9%)
 - 18+ (one dose): 84.0%
 - COVID-19 vaccination clinics

Updates

- Colorado: <u>hyenas</u> test positive for SARS-CoV-2
- FDA authorizes a <u>booster</u> dose of all three US COVID-19 vaccines (<u>Delaware specifics</u>); <u>CDC</u> follows suit
- Germany: new cases up 60% in the past two weeks
- Philadelphia to require COVID-19 vaccination for city employees
