- Percentage of tests positive: 7.7%

- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (<u>MyHealthyCommunity</u>)
 - As of October 10, Delaware has administered 1,205,728 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine
 - Fully Vaccinated: 551,801 (57.6%)
 - One Dose: 584,201 (61.0%)
 - 18+ (one dose): 79.7%
 - COVID-19 vaccination clinics

Updates

- Merck asks US FDA to authorize promising anti-COVID pill
- Navajo Nation: no COVID-19 deaths for 7th time in 10 days
- NCI study: Pandemic's <u>disproportionate</u> impact on Black, American Indian/Alaska Native, and Latino adults
- NIH: People with substance use disorders may be at higher risk for SARS-CoV-2 breakthrough infections
