- Eris increases as new COVID-19 hospitalizations decline
- High maternal stress combined with prenatal <u>COVID-19</u> infection may affect attention span in infants
- Recommended composition of <u>flu</u>vaccines for use in 2024 southern hemisphere influenza season
- <u>SARS-CoV-2</u> infects coronary arteries, increases plaque inflammation
