Avian-Bovine-Human Flu Transmission

Updated: 9/12/24.

Human cases: 14 (current outbreak)

- 4 following exposure to dairy cows (report) (TX-1, MI-2, CO-1)
- 9 following exposure to poultry (report) (CO)
- 1 under investigation with no known animal exposure (MO)
- Current public health risk: LOW
- CDC flu surveillance systems show no indicators of unusual influenza activity in people, including avian influenza A(H5N1).
- 9 of the 14 H5 human cases have been confirmed as H5N1
