Updates

- The FDA [advisory panel](#): 16-to-2 against extra vaccine doses, and 18-to-0 for boosters for those aged 65 and older, or who are immunocompromised.
 - [NIH](#) to build study population to support research on long-term effects of COVID-19
 - Pfizer releases trial results of COVID vaccine in [children aged 5-11](#)
 - Study: mRNA COVID-19 vaccine [allergic reactions](#) rare, and typically mild
 - Study: [Risk prediction](#) of COVID-19 related death and serious illness in adults post COVID-19 vaccination
