- Percentage of tests positive: 7.7%

- Delaware Vaccine Release Tracker (MyHealthyCommunity)
 - As of September 19, Delaware has administered 1,150,323 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine
 - Fully Vaccinated: 514,683 (53.8%)
 - One Dose: 570,149 (53.8%)
 - 18+ (one dose): 77.6%
 - COVID-19 vaccination clinics

Updates

- The FDA <u>advisory panel</u>: 16-to-2 against extra vaccine doses, and 18-to-0 for boosters for those aged 65 and older, or who are immunocompromised.
- NIH to build study population to support research on long-term effects of COVID-19
- Pfizer releases trial results of COVID vaccine in children aged 5-11
- Study: mRNA COVID-19 vaccine allergic reactions rare, and typically mild
- Study: <u>Risk prediction</u> of COVID-19 related death and serious illness in adults post COVID-19 vaccination
